Donald is Head of the Department of Hospitality, Leisure and Tourism Management at Oxford Brookes University, a position he has held since 2003, and Chair and Co-founder of Oxford Gastronomica, a specialist centre for the study of food, drink and culture. In 2003 he was the first recipient of the Martin Radcliffe Fellowship in Gastronomy, funded by the Savoy Educational Trust.
