Sandy Black is Professor of Fashion & Textile Design & Technology at London College of Fashion. She is Director of the Centre of Fashion Science at LCF - a group which aims to develop collaborative and trans-disciplinary research to harness existing and emerging technologies with potential application to fashion and textiles. All research is design-led, in the context of sustainability for better lives, and with potential relevance and impact for industry. Sandy set up the Interrogating Fashion network in 2005 and is currently leading an EPSRC/AHRC funded project Considerate Design for Personalised Fashion products. She developed and edits the new journal *Fashion Practice: Design, Creative Process and the Fashion Industry* (Berg). Sandy's publications include *Eco Chic: the Fashion Paradox* (Black Dog Publishing 2008) and *Knitwear in Fashion* (Thames & Hudson 2002,2005)
